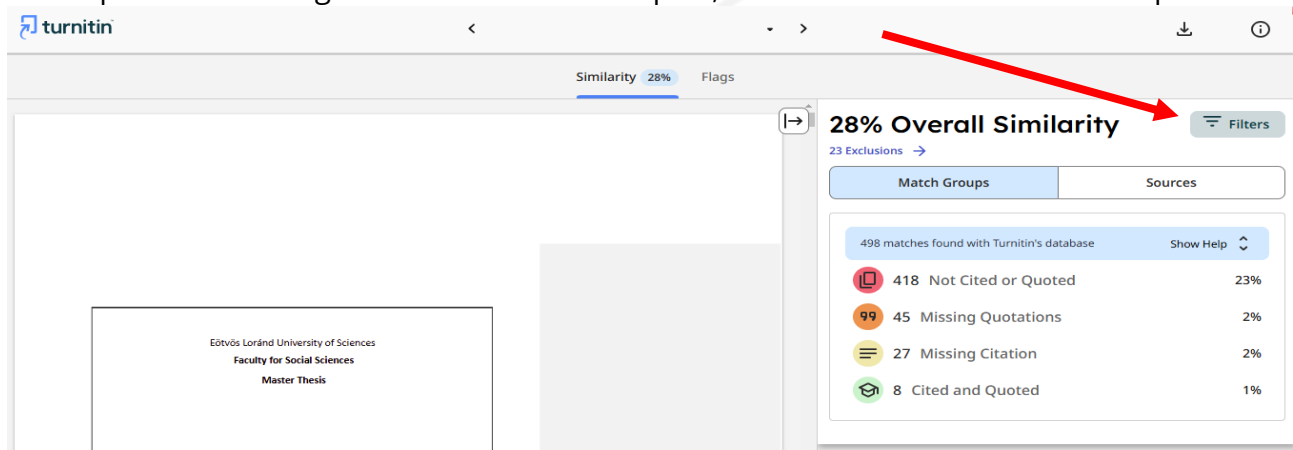

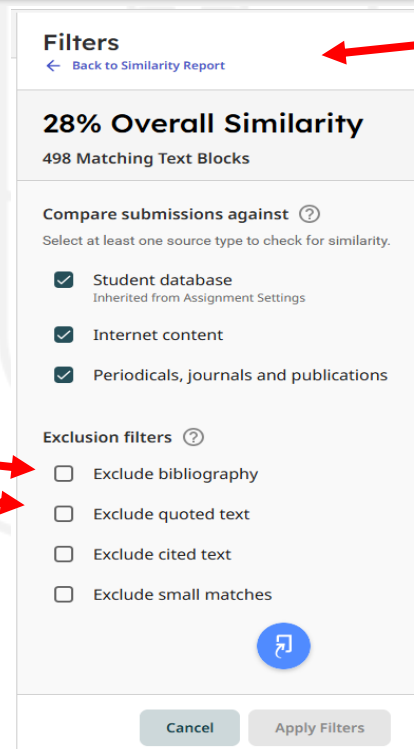


## Using filters

It is possible to exclude the content of the bibliography from the text match display. This is possible with the 'filter' option. If you check this, the content of the report will change, but it is also possible to generate a new report, so both versions are preserved



When using filters, it is recommended to exclude bibliography and quoted texts.
